Prior to entering Esquimalt Harbour you **MUST** call Port Security on Channel 10 and report the name of your boat, number of people on board and your destination (CFSA) and keep clear of all military facilities such as wharves, yellow buoys define the closest allowable approach. Located on the North side of Esquimalt Harbour near the Dept. Public Works dry dock, When Fisgard green can buoy is abeam to port, steer 070 true for .75 miles to the left hand caisson. The caissons have **CFSA** in 7 foot letters on the seaward side. Enter marina with caissons to starboard and green light to port. Stay close to caissons to avoid rocks 40 yards north of the left hand end of the caissons and marked by a green light. Proceed past "B" float and moor at next float until another berth is assigned. Register at either the bar or the double trailer below the clubhouse, bar open Tuesday to Sunday inclusive if neither is available contact Bill Brekelmans at 250-480-4919. First 2 days are free, showers, water and 15 amp power no charge, see duty bartender for code to gates, clubhouse open Tuesday to Sunday, bus into Victoria available for \$2.25 each way exact fare is required, at Admirals Road off Maple Bank Road.
